



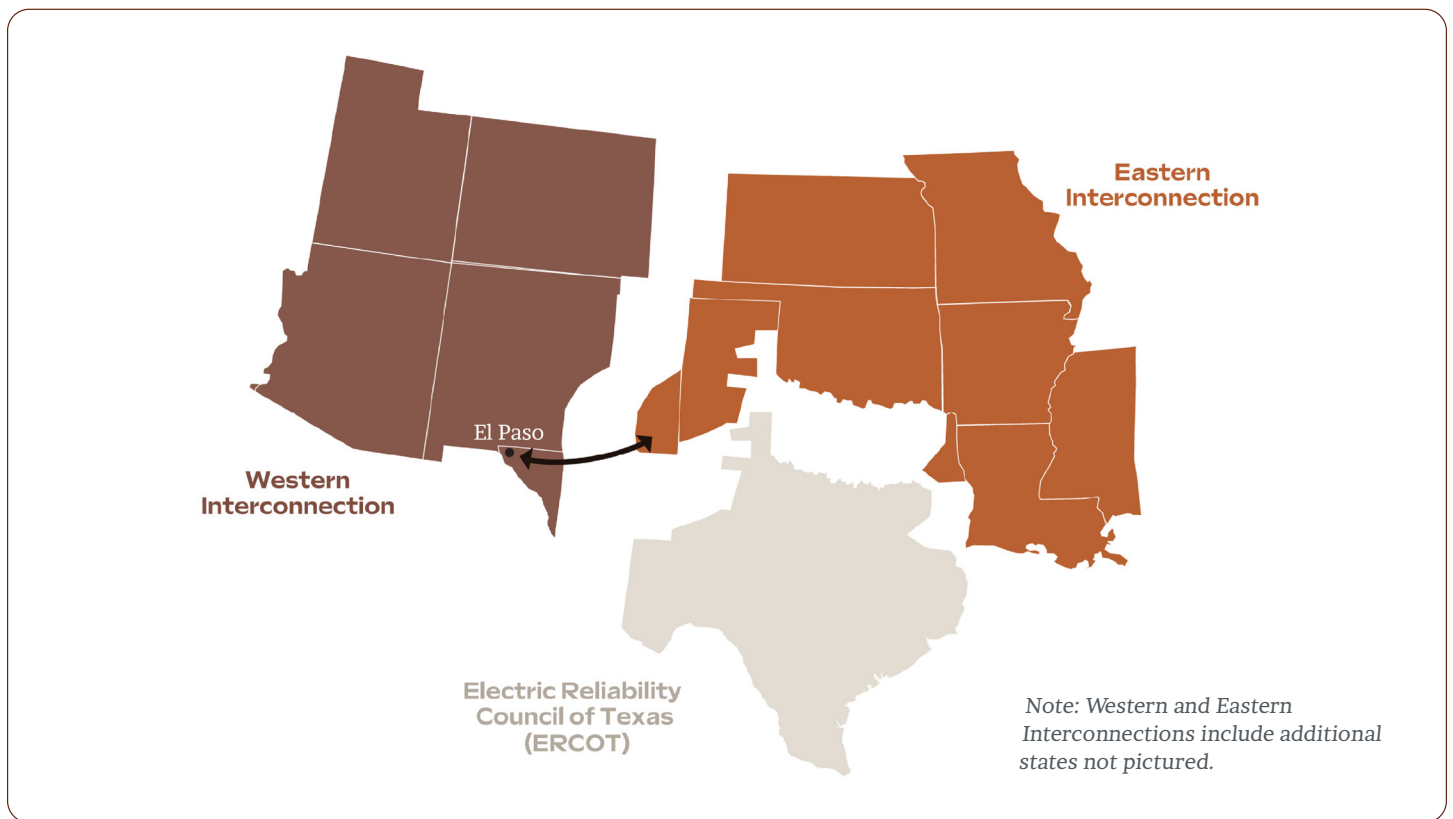
PECOS WEST

Overview

Pecos West is a high-voltage direct current (HVDC) transmission line that will link the rapidly growing metro area of El Paso, Texas, with southeastern New Mexico. Pecos West creates a vital connection between the Western and Eastern Interconnections of the U.S. electric grid. Pecos West will bidirectionally transport all sources of electricity and enable electricity generated on both ends of the line to access key markets, while strengthening the overall electric system in the Desert Southwest.



Project Status

Pecos West is in the planning and development phase, collaborating with local stakeholders to determine a preliminary route for the transmission line. Construction would commence after Pecos West obtains the necessary regulatory approvals and secures all needed land rights. Pecos West could be operational in the mid-2030s.

Project Benefits



Pecos West represents a **multi-billion-dollar grid reliability investment** in the Desert Southwest. Pecos West will strengthen the region's electric system and provide economic benefits through job creation, additional tax revenue, and financial support for landowners and communities.



Pecos West will result in tens of millions of dollars annually of **economic benefits** for host communities. Desert Southwest towns and cities will benefit from additional property tax revenue, construction and operations and maintenance jobs, and direct community investments.



Pecos West will enhance **energy security** in El Paso and beyond. With high-capacity connections to new markets, Pecos West will contribute to a more resilient grid and help keep the lights on during extreme weather events.
